Navy commissions first LMS 'KD Keris'

PETALING JAYA: The first Littoral Mission Ship, the KD Keris, has been officially commissioned by the Royal Malaysian Navy.

The ceremony, which was held at

the Wuchuan Shipbuilding Industry Co Ltd, Wucang Port, Qidong in China, was launched by Navy chief

Admiral Tan Sri Mohd Reza Mohd

Admiral Ian Sri Mond Reza Mond Sany on Monday. Among those who attended the event were Defence Ministry deputy secretary-general (development) Mastura Ahmad Mustafa as well as the top management of Boustead Naval Shipyard Sdn Bhd (BNSSB)

and China Shipbuilding & Offshore International Co Ltd (CSOC).

Admiral Mohd Reza read out the commission order to commemorate KD Keris being commissioned as well as installed the command insignia to Commander Mohd Zulkarnain Mohd Rawi, who will be the ship's

first commanding officer.
Construction of the ship started on
July 31, 2018 at the Wuchuan
Shuangliu Manufacture Base, Wuhan.

"It has gone through various tests before being handed over to the gov-ernment," the navy said.
