





Fiscal challenges and the geopolitics and geostrategic has called for RMN to roll out a new transformation and modernization plan called "15to5":







RMN Development Expenditure trend – Dream vs Reality






Why **#15to5** Fleet Transformation Programme?

Phasing out of the older vessels in the fleet, streamlining and creative optimisation of OE & DE through savings in maintenance and operations cost




- Potential savings from phasing out older vessels from 15 classes to 5 classes, improvement in asset management and procurement processes as well as optimisation of approved budget
- This will translate to additional savings which will be used to fund "15 to 5" plan, and at the same time contribute towards strengthening local shipyards and defence industry


#15to5 Journey is well underway after broad-based strategic formulation, and implementation success will continue to be accelerated


