Navy staff are warned against bullying

SANDAKAN: Navy staff in the Eastern Fleet Headquarters that violate work ethics will not be tolerated.

The Royal Malaysian Navy (RMN) Eastern Fleet Commander, Rear Admiral Datuk Pahlawan Syed Zahrul Putra Syed Abdullah, said they must stay committed in carrying out daily tasks.

"Stay away from acts that violate service laws such as bullying, it is unlawful and violates RMN work ethic.

"We will not tolerate anyone who is found guilty of such offences at the East Fleet," he said when speaking in conjunction with his first visit to Markas Wilayah Laut 2 (Mawilla 2) or Maritime Region 2, Wednesday.

This visit was to provide a clearer picture of the administration, operations and structure of Mawilla 2 as well as units under the auspices of Sabah's East Coast.

Since taking over the administration of the East Fleet since October 15, 2019, this is Syed Zahrul's first official visit to Mawilla 2 as well as the all other units located on the East Coast of Sabah.

In the framework of this visit, he also took the opportunity to visit around Sandakan Naval Base, RMN family home (RK-

TLDM) as well as several other facilities.

Apart from being able to see and feel the atmosphere in Sandakan Naval Base, the visit also served as a field for Mawilla 2 to present the ongoing development plans as well as those that is still in the pipeline.

Mawilla 2 was officially opened at Sandakan RMN Base on August 30, 2017.

Since then, many improvements have

been made in areas such as operational, administrative, Family Home (RK), as well as a number of other basic facilities to meet current needs that are also compatible with its function as a Headquarters.

Meanwhile, during the three-day visit, Syed Zahrul also attended a friendly session with the Sandakan Navy people before visiting KD SRI Tawau.
